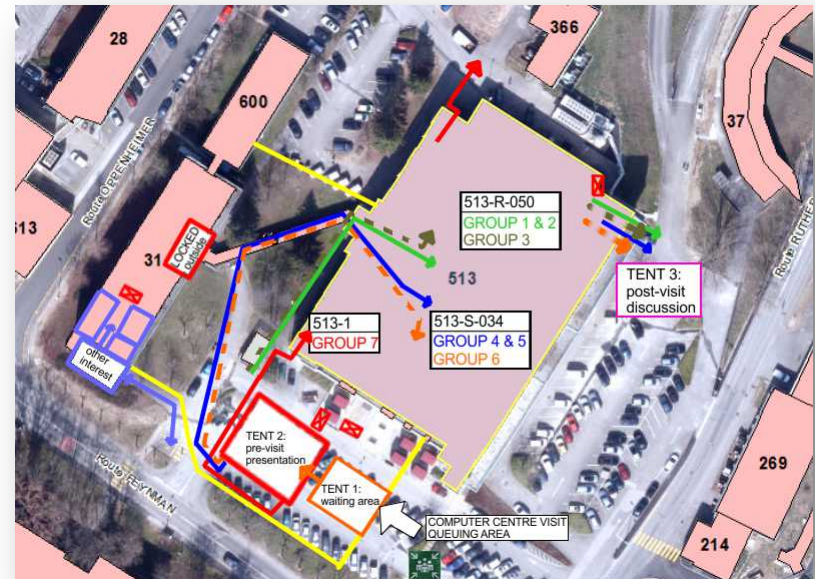




- Visitors Flow - overview:

- 150 visitors / 15 minutes into waiting area
  - divided into 7 groups:
  - Group 1 (no en/fr): 513 1<sup>st</sup> floor (30 visitors)
  - Group 2,3,4: CC tour R-050 (20 visitors per group)
  - Group 5,6,7: CC tour S-034
- 
- 2 guides per group,
  - in addition non-en/fr language experts on 1<sup>st</sup> floor of 513

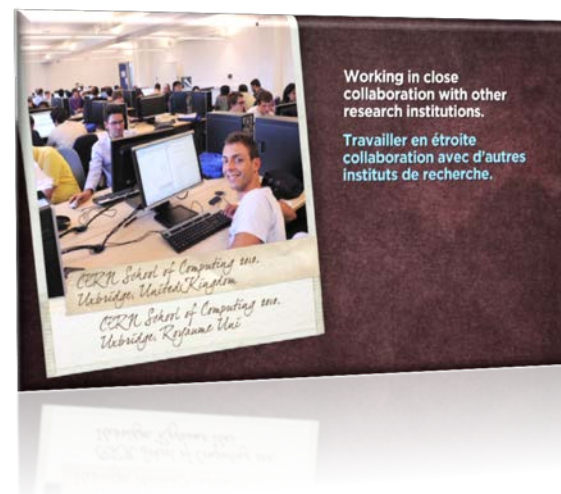

- Roads closed for public (Sat & Sun 8:00-21:00):

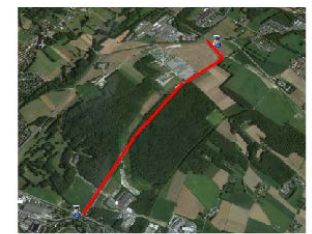
- the road in front of the Meyrin site
