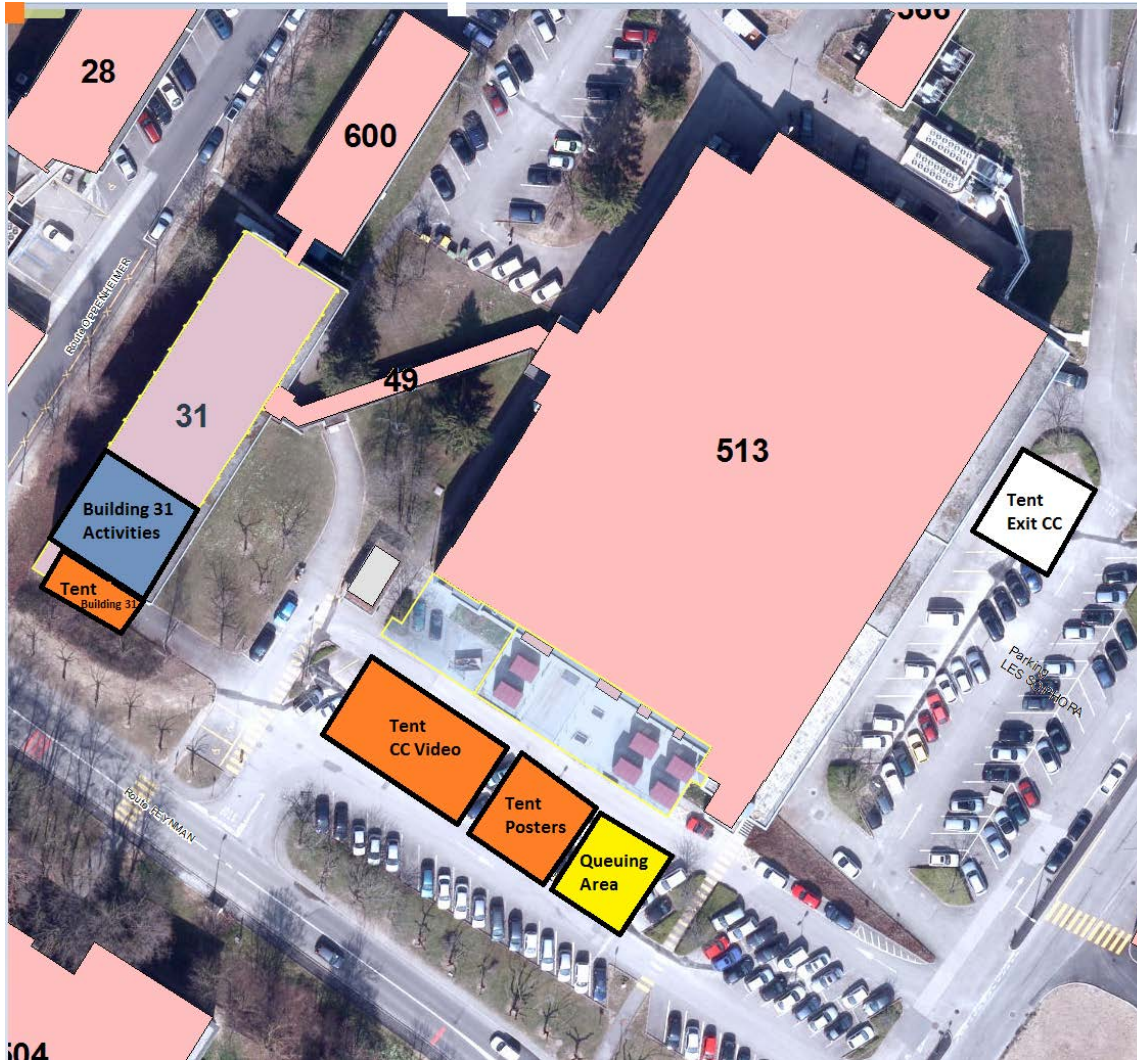

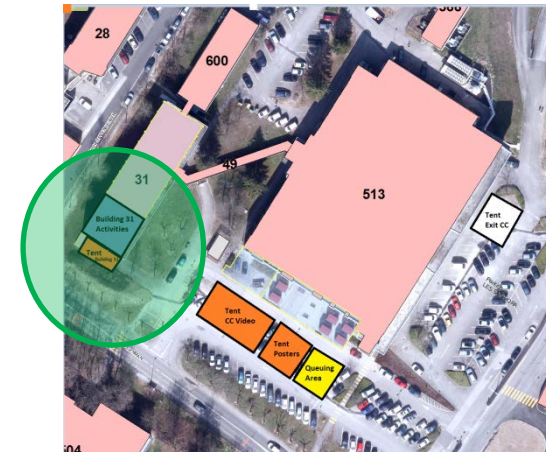


- Tent Building 31:

 - If full, ask visitors to wait until places become available.



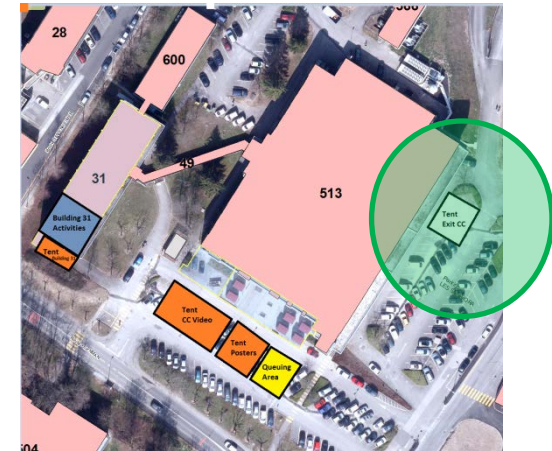

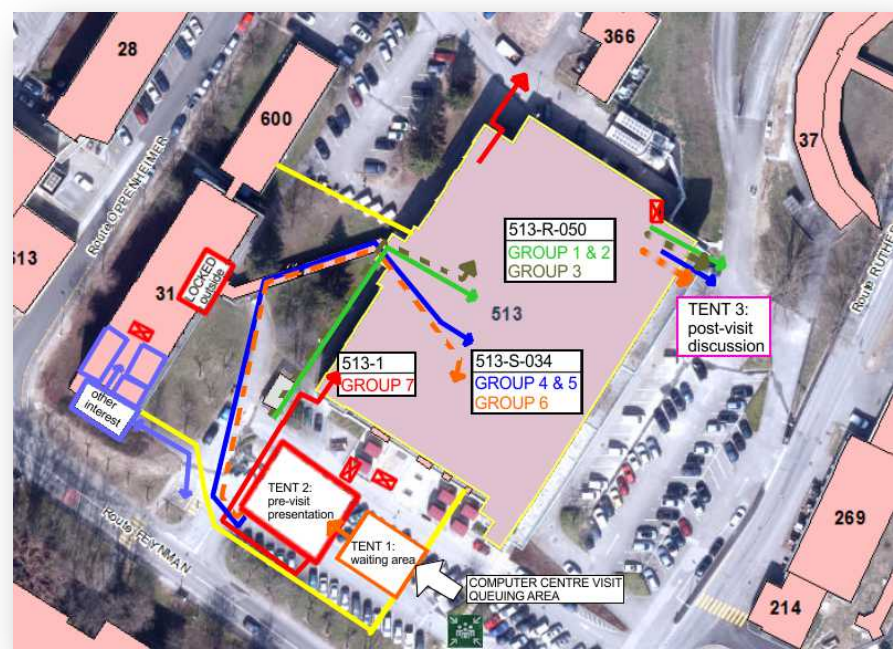
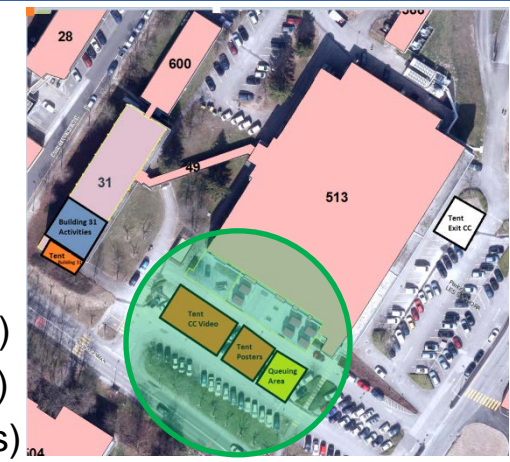
- Tasks:

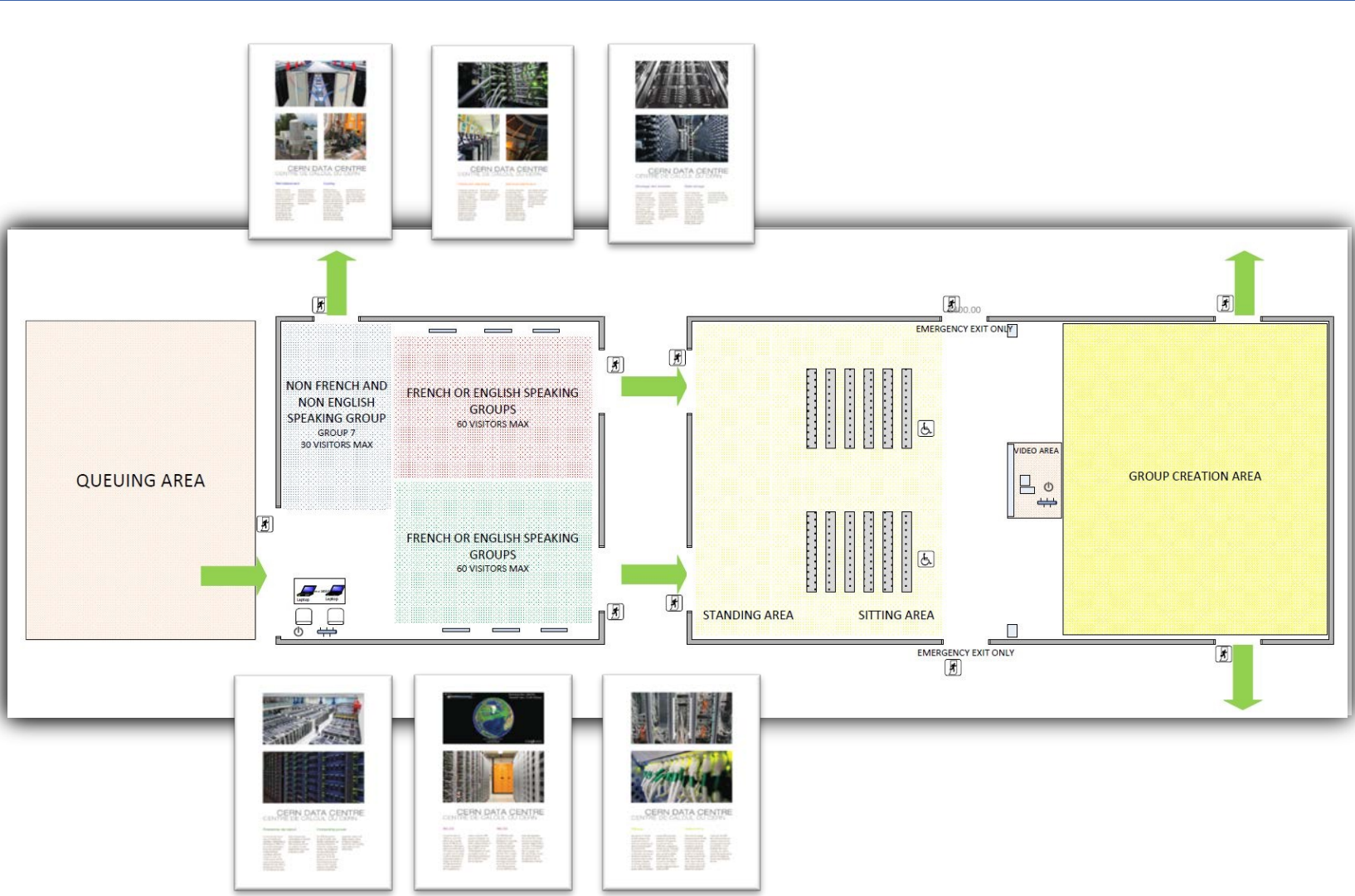
- Give CC Souvenir to visitors:
 - “Sticky Screen Wipe”
mobile phone screen cleaner
 - Information to visitors:
 - What else to see at CC:
Grid Café, Google Liquid Galaxy, Wigner Room
 - Give directions to R2, Bus stop, Info Point etc.
 - Check that Exit of CC is Exit only!





- Welcome & Video Tent::
 - Visitors Flow - overview:
 - 150 visitors / 15 minutes
 - divided into 7 groups, organised by language:
 - Group 1,2,3: CC tour R-050 (20 per group)
 - Group 4,5,6: CC tour S-034 (20 per group)
 - Group 7 (no en/fr): 513 1st floor (30 visitors)



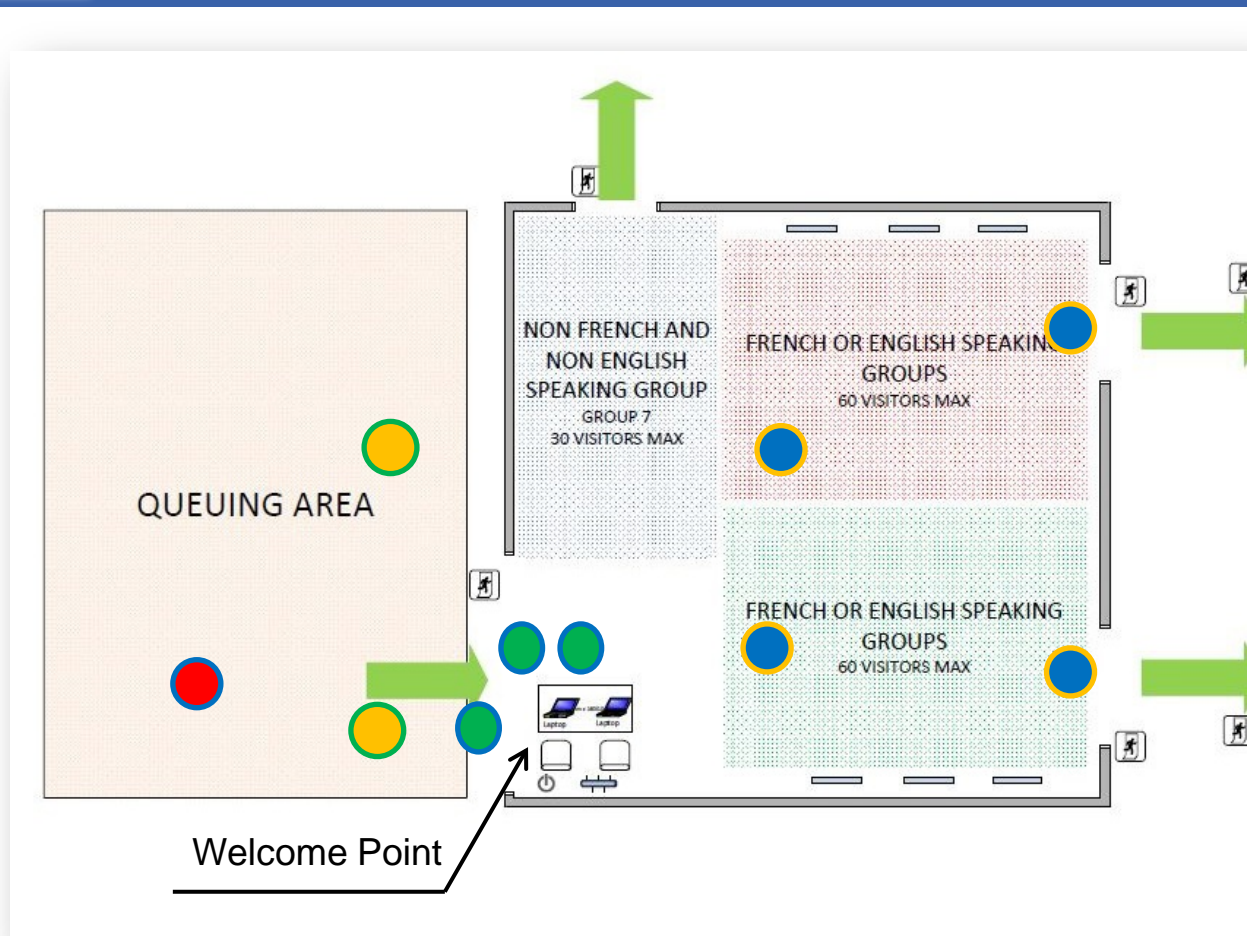

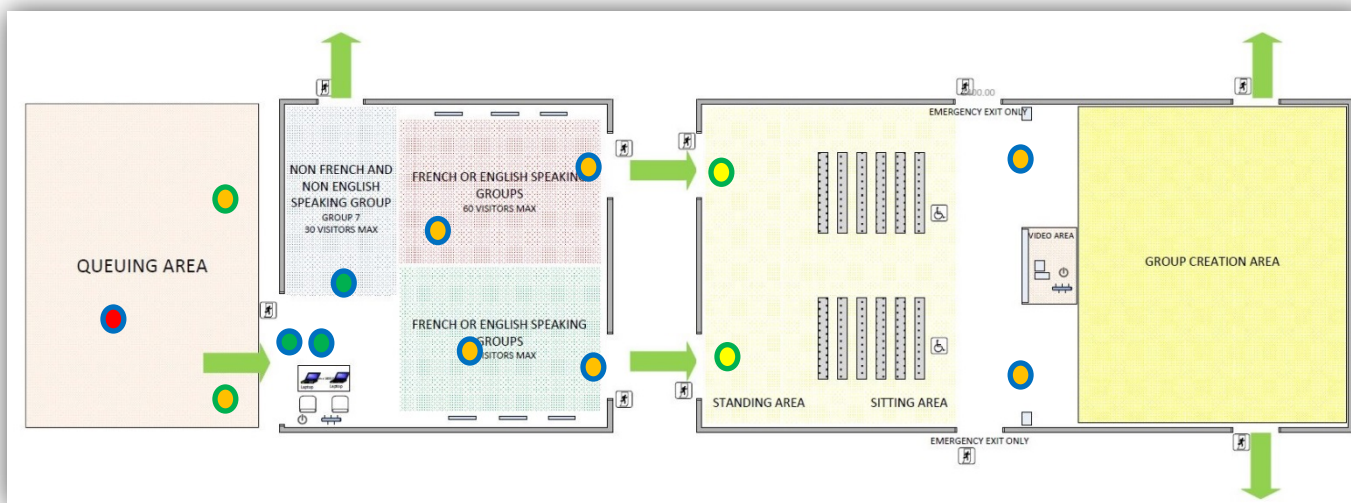


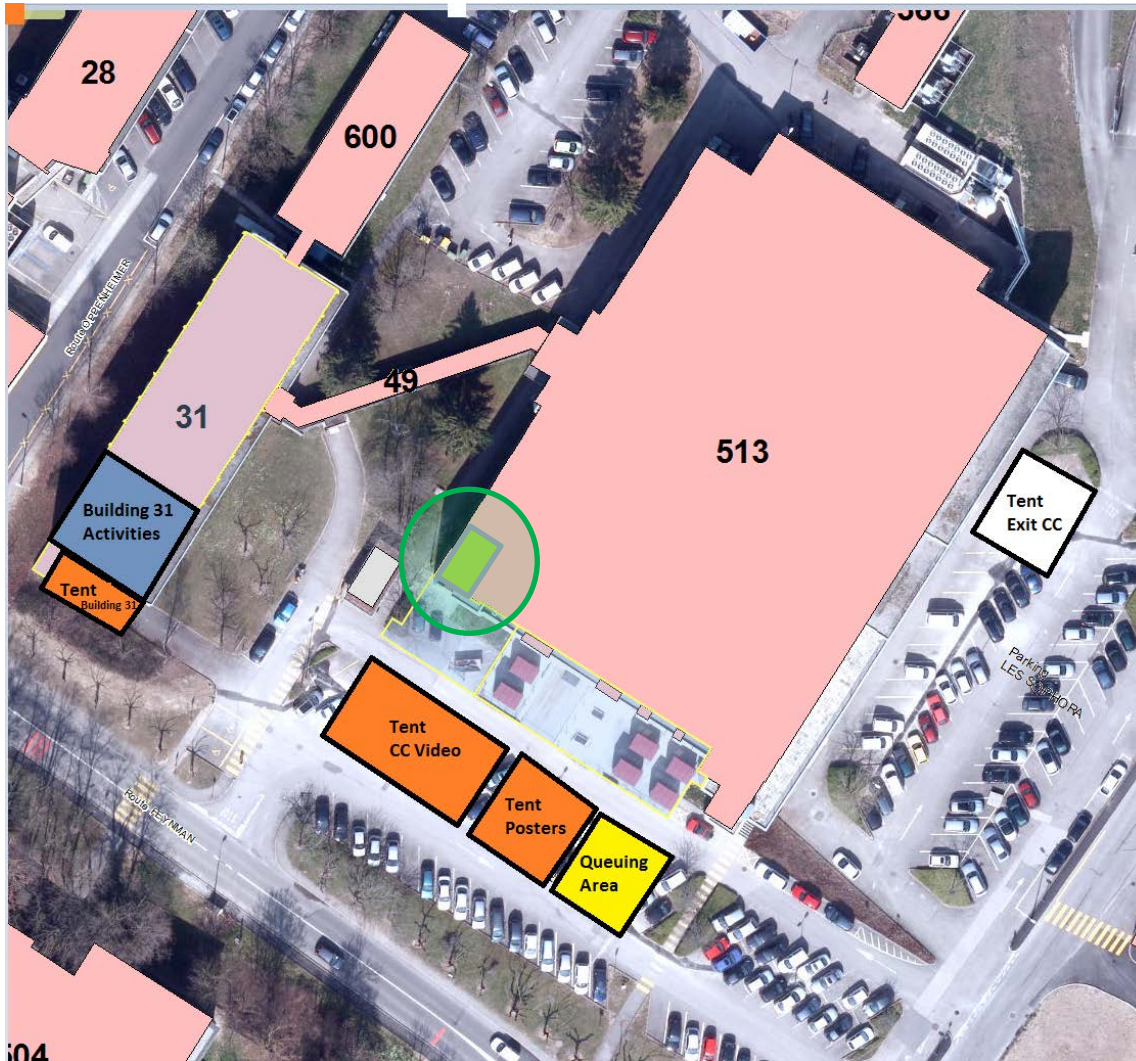
Note: Journalists have priority on other visitors to visit the sites provided that they have registered and can show their journalist green card. If no journalist card they have to register close to the main entrance and come back.





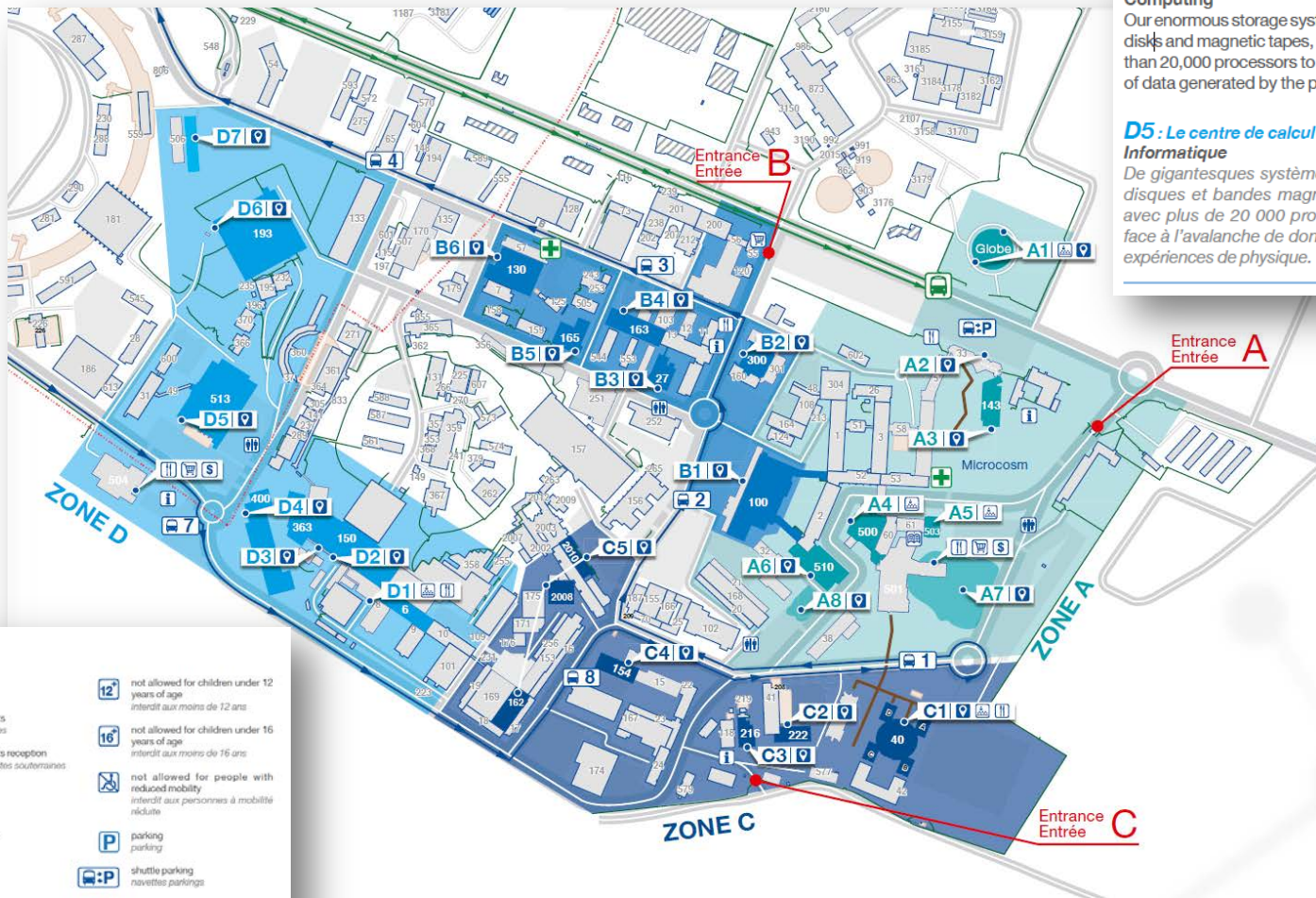
- **Welcome & Video Tent - Volunteers**
 - **Welcome Point (3 persons):**
 - Every 15 min fill tent with 150 visitors
 - Direct them depending on language preference (en, fr, non en/fr)
Target: 6 x 20 visitors + 30 visitors (incl. non en/fr).
 - **Animators Main Tents (6 persons + animators + ...):**
 - **Main Tent: Group people (in 20 per language)**
 - **Video Tent: Group people (in 20 per language)**
 - Entrance, start video, form groups of 20 and hand them to CC guides
